KOZEL

4.0% £3.00

Kozel, which means 'goat' in Czech, has been brewed in Velké Popovice since 1874 and families from the village have worked at the brewery for generations. Less conventional though, is the fact that the brewery also boasts a goat in its head count: Jaroslav, named after the general manager of the brewery.

THEAKSTONS BEST BITTER

3.8% £3.30

The definitive English Bitter. This fine, golden coloured beer, has a full flavour that lingers pleasantly on the palate. With a good bitter-sweet balance this beer has a robust hop character described as citrus and spicy.

PILSNER URQUELL

4.4% £3.50

The result of a revolutionary new brewing process that in 1842, produced the worlds first clear golden beer. Still made with the original recipe.

ASAHI, SUPER DRY

5.0% £3.50

Super crisp, super clear and super dry, Asahi Super Dry embodies Japanese discernment and good taste. Asahi, pronounced 'A-Sa-Hee', means 'rising sun' and was developed in 1987 as Japan's first karakuchi or 'dry' beer.

Peroni Nastro Azzurro is an intensely crisp and refreshing lager with an unmistakable touch of Italian style brewed in Italy to the original recipe conceived in 1963

QUILMES 330ml

4.9% £3.50

Argentina's favourite beer comes from the capital, Buenos Aires. It is a premium 4.9% lager style beer, made from the finest hops sourced from Patagonia and using the purest water from the Andes mountain range.

CUESQUENA 330ml

5.0% £3.50

Produced with only the finest natural ingredients near the mystical lost city of Machu Picchu, Cusquena is crafted from the purest mountain water from a source at 18,000 feet in the Andes

VEDETT 330ml

5.0% £3.60

Well-hopped premium blonde beer, simply fantastic.

GUINNESS SURGER 520ml

4.1% £3.60

Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm. Settle. Breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward.

BUDVAR 500ml

5.0% £3.80

Brewed from nothing but local natural materials in a 100 days brewing cycle (90 spent fermenting) it is universally regarded as one of the world's great lager conditioned beers.

WYLD WOOD ORGANIC APPLE CIDER 500ML

6.5% £3.80

This cider is produced using organic cider apples and matured in old oak vats which results in an easy to drink cider with a ripe apple aroma and a refreshing well balanced taste.

WYLD WOOD ORGANIC PEAR CIDER 500ML

6.4% £3.80

The smooth flavour of ripe pears and hints of summer fruits, citrus, honey and spice.

TIMMERMANS KREICK 330ML

3.0% £3.80

Timmermans is one of a handful of traditional Lambic breweries from the outskirts of Brussels. The addition of fruit to an unusual wheat beer creates fermentation.

DUVEL 330ML

8.6% £4.00

Flemish for "Devil" this is a strong golden ale. Lots of complex aromas like malt, pear drops and peppery hops with a clean, well-structured finish.

ERDINGER 500ml

5.3% £4.00

Brewed using fine yeast according to a traditional recipe, the beer is still bottle-fermented in the traditional way to produce a delicious German wheat beer.

ERDINGER DUNKEL 500ml

5.6% £4.00

This dark wheat beer is rich and smooth with a chocolaty taste and aroma. It owes its full-bodied flavour to the fine hops and dark malt used in its production.
