62	CHARDONNAY, CURLY FLAT 2005 Situating in the Macedon Ranges North of Melbourne Curly Flat is in one of the coolest areas in Australia for vine growing. This helps give the wine an elegance and style more akin to good Puligny Montrachet than Aussie chardonnay.	Australia	Victoria	13.9%	£37.00

71	TOCAI FRIULANO, MIANI 2006 Enzo Pontoni's whole production from a mere 18 hectares is a measly 8000 bottles a year, so as you can imagine it is extremely difficult to find his wines in Italy, let alone over here. This wine has a texture and richness more commonly associated with 'Grand Cru' Alsace wines than Italian. Rich and smooth quince fruit with tropical nuances all balanced by clean citrus acidity. 72	CHABLIS, GRAND CRU 'LES GRENOUILLES', DANIEL-ETIENNE DEFAIX 2004 Only five owners have access to this, the smallest Grand Cru in Chablis, making this wine is a real jewel in the crown of Chablis.
